the women we work with report a sizable **increase in confidence and a decrease in anxiety and depression:** feeling supported, empowered and trusted **makes a life-changing difference to their wellbeing and perceived prospects.** this self belief and community acceptance is key to creating **a promising future** outside prison walls.

every woman that has entered our programme has expressed strong anxiety about release, not only in terms of finding work or housing, but also of being judged for their past. **working with us, alongside our bespoke support as they leave prison, helps them to overcome these worries and sets them up for success.**
